Class 2B: Mandatory for all FIS competitions out of country. Mandatory for all athletes / coaches for Canada Snowboard sanctioned out of country travel, training and competitions. Maximum trip duration not to exceed 25 days without approval. Requests for out-of-country trips of more than 25 consecutive days will be reviewed on a trip-by-trip basis.
